#### **Background (ISMOCD)**

The Indian Society for Malaria and Other Communicable Diseases (ISMOCD) is the oldest public health association with more than 2100 life members working towards carrying forward the agenda of prevention, control and elimination of communicable diseases through updates, recent advances, research priorities, challenges and opportunities with regard to new re-emerging diseases. ISMOCD is an apex organization with good credibility and its good health influence in the country. ISMOCD is in practice to organize bi-annual conferences at different locations in the country. This time, ICMR-NIMR Delhi has been chosen as the venue for ISMOCD Conference –2025 after having recent conferences at Trivandrum, Cochin, Pune, Bengaluru and Goa respectively.

#### Venue: ICMR-NIMR (Delhi)

Delhi is the capital of India and has more than 30 historical places to explore by the visitors. The Red Fort, one of the iconic historical places in Delhi, stands as a testament to India's rich cultural and architectural heritage. Commissioned by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in the 17th century, this majestic fort showcases stunning red sandstone architecture. Among others, Qutub Minar, Hauz Khas Fort, Humayun's Tomb, Rashtrapati Bhawan, Jantar Mantar, Akshardham Temple, Lotus Temple, Lodhi Gardens, Agrasen ki Baoli, Purana Quila, Tughlaqabad Fort, Mehrauli Archaeological Park, Jahanpanah Fort, Jama Masjid, Safdarjung Tomb and many more are of tourist attraction.

National Institute of Malaria Research, New Delhi, is a premier Institute of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) with a mandate to support the national malaria control program through basic applied and operational research aiming to eliminate malaria from the country. The primary task of the Institute is to find short-term as well as long-term solutions to the problems of malaria through basic, applied and operational field research. The Institute also plays a key role in manpower resource development through trainings/workshops and transfer of technology.

### **Climate in Delhi**

Climate in Delhi January and February, New Delhi experiences cold winter weather, with daytime temperatures averaging between 10°C to 20°C (50°F to 68°F) and colder nights dropping to around 5°C (41°F) or lower. Foggy mornings are common, and dense fog can lead to delays for flights and trains, especially in the early hours. Participants are advised to monitor their travel schedules and check for real-time updates on potential delays. For comfort, pack warm clothing suitable for layered dressing, including sweaters, jackets, and scarves. Early mornings and evenings tend to be quite chilly, so a winter coat and warm accessories are recommended to stay comfortable throughout the day.
